Dear DESG colleagues,

You may recall that on November 3, 2020, the JOP circulated its report recommending endorsement of the **Institute for Information Industry (III)** to serve as an **Accountability Agent in the CBPR System** for Chinese Taipei.

Since that time, Chinese Taipei has worked to address concerns with III's application. Specifically, III revised its application in January 2020 to remove the Foundation Act and the Personal Data Protection Act, the full texts and the headings in the table of contents, because those documents include words in the legislation that may relate to nomenclature issues which cannot be altered. Chinese Taipei revised the documents in the Appendices accordingly but did not alter the substance of the application (revised documents attached for reference).

Given that the report has been pending for more than six months and in my role as JOP Chair, I kindly request members to submit any substantive concerns **by Thursday, 3 June 2021**, or the application will be deemed endorsed.
