However, due to the global spread of Covid-19 pandemic, most international conferences have been cancelled or postponed, and the international academic exchange has been deeply affected. Fortunately, the domestic epidemic situation is well controlled, and our school has been organizing many notional and international conferences in various fields, calling for paper contributions. In order to encourage the active submission of our students to conferences, so as to improve academic exchange and research results, we therefore offer the plan of Grants for Students Presenting Papers at International or National Conference.

- I. Qualifications for application: Applicants must be general students of our school (including junior college students, master students, and doctoral students) who have submitted full papers or long abstract (not limited to Chinese or English) to the international or national conferences hosted by our school, and completed registration.
- II. Grant amount: 500 NTD per paper or long abstract (limited to one person).
- III. Required documents for review:
 1. Application: application form (original), paper acceptance letter (photocopy)
 2. Verification: receipt of registration (photocopy)
- IV. Application time: From now until October 19, Monday (deadline).
- V. Time for verification of grants: expected to be from October 26 (Mon) to November 2 (Mon).
- VI. Time for granting awards: The list of awards and grants will be sent to the school's administrative process after the collective signatures are completed. It is expected to be credited before December 31.
- VII. Application steps and precautions:
 1. Please submit the paper application form (the original one must be signed), send photocopy of paper acceptance letter to the Research and Development Office by application deadline, and email the electronic files of the two application documents to chiaotai@nfu.edu.tw .
 2. After the application deadline, all the application will be consolidated and compiled. Applicants will be notified to stop by the office to sign the award list with the attachment of the registration fee receipt (photocopy); please pay attention to the mailbox notification at that time.
 3. If there are multiple authors for each paper or long abstract, only the presenter (only one) will be granted.
